## Discussion Questions

- 1 How does seeing Jesus as the true form of what we were supposed to be affect your understanding of your life?
- 2 How do you think Jesus knew the Scriptures? How can you cultivate a deeper knowledge of Scripture, similar to what Jesus demonstrated during his life?
- 3 Reflect on a time when you felt alone or abandoned. How can Jesus' experience on the cross provide comfort to you?
- 4 Paul Earnhart said, "Jesus did not die just so our sins could be forgiven; he died so that we could be transformed." How does scripture reveal that you can actively participate in the transforming power of Jesus?
